


# Costa Brava Inclusive Mobile Film

2nd international mobile short film competition featuring inclusive tourism experiences in the Costa Brava and Girona Pyrenees.

## Terms and Conditions

**Topic:** inclusive holiday in the Costa Brava or Girona Pyrenees that involves people with disabilities

**Production year:** 2016–2017

**Unreleased:** has not been commercially released

**Genre:** open (fiction, documentary, news report, tourist experience, etc.)

**Maximum length:** 3 minutes

Each participant can submit a **maximum of 2 short films**

**Participation:** free and open to all

## Short film submission

**Festival dates:** 27 to 30 September 2017

## Criteria

Films will be judged on creativity, innovation and artistic contributions.

The film's ability to impact, speak to and attract viewers.

The promotion of inclusion and presenting the region and its tourism experiences as accessible to everyone.

## Recommendations

Horizontal video.

Royalty free (Creative Commons) music or your own.

## Screening

The films may be screened at various venues over the course of the festival.

Short film owners, those who enter the film in the competition and accredited festival participants can request a maximum of 10 tickets to attend the screening.

## Rights

By entering the competition participants transfer exhibit rights for non-profit purposes to the Costa Brava Girona Tourist Board for any tourism promotion space, medium or platform deemed appropriate, within and outside the festival dates and not limited to the Costa Brava and Girona Pyrenees.

The participant authorises the Girona Film Festival - Handicapped to exhibit the film at the venues selected for screening and at promotional activities for the festival.

The contact person who enters the film in the competition shall represent the film's owners, be accountable for the film's originality and transfer the rights to the Costa Brava Girona Tourist Board for public viewing.

The Costa Brava Girona Tourist Board shall not be held liable for any material used in the submitted films that infringes on copyrights.

## Judging process

The jury is comprised of a president and other members (jury must be odd-numbered). If a jury member fails to attend and the jury is even-numbered, the president may cast an honorary vote.

The jury members will watch the short films and meet to deliberate.

Each jury member will propose candidates for the award, the jury will discuss the various candidates and then a vote will be held to decide the winner.

The result of the jury's deliberation is secret until the winners are named at the awards ceremony, unless otherwise noted.

## Awards

The award for **BEST COSTA BRAVA INCLUSIVE MOBILE FILM SHORT FILM** for screenplay, direction and production shall be collected by the film's director, producer, screenwriter, or representative.

The prize consists of €500 for the best short film about **about an inclusive tourism experience on the Costa Brava** and €500 for the best short film about **an inclusive tourism experience in the Girona Pyrenees**.

**An Achievement Award** will be given for the best short film shot by children under 16 years old that showcases an inclusive tourist experience in the region.

If deemed appropriate, a prize may be awarded to the winner of the Achievement Award.

## Important

Short films entered into the competition that do not win will not be saved.

Entering the competition implies acceptance of these rules.

If any changes are made to the rules for reasons of force majeure, amendments will be made and the rules will be published again.
